African American Youth Harvest Foundation (AAYHF): A Proven Model for Empowerment and Support



Since its founding in 2006, the African American Youth Harvest Foundation (AAYHF) has been a cornerstone of support, empowerment, and transformation for underserved youth and families in Travis County and the broader Central Texas region. Located in East Austin, AAYHF has become a trusted, community-based leader in providing culturally responsive, wraparound services that uplift and equip individuals from all backgrounds—especially communities of color—to thrive.

Our Mission in Action

Originally launched through the AAYHF Conference Series—one of Central Texas's largest youth- and school-centered initiatives—AAYHF has served thousands of students and families with specialized programming in education, workforce readiness, and social-emotional development. Today, our impact has expanded to include:

- Mentoring & life coaching
- Workforce development & career exposure
- STEM & media training programs
- Parent support & advocacy
- Year-round summer camps and enrichment
- Emergency resource access (food, hygiene, technology, housing)

AAYHF's approach is responsive, relationship-driven, and holistic. We continuously adapt to community needs through both formal tools (e.g., intake forms, surveys) and informal feedback (e.g., conversations with parents, shifts in service demand).

Expanding the Vision: The Harvest Trauma Recovery Center (HTRC)

In 2023, we launched the Harvest Trauma Recovery Center (HTRC)—the first of its kind in Texas—to directly address the unmet mental health and trauma recovery needs of youth and adults impacted by violence. HTRC offers:

- Trauma-informed therapy
- Housing and transportation assistance
- Food, clothing, and childcare support
- Continuity of care beyond crisis points

HTRC is built on the foundation that healing must be integrated with stability and opportunity. Services are prioritized for clients already enrolled in AAYHF programs, ensuring trusted and sustained support.

Contractual & Funding Partnerships Powering Our Work

Our service delivery model is made possible through foundational contracts and key partnerships:

1. City of Austin – Cradle to Career Initiative

Supports a comprehensive suite of services including:

- Mentoring
- STEM education
- Case management & life skills

2. Travis County – Youth Development Services

Focused on communities outside Austin city limits, especially Manor, this contract funds:

- Academic enrichment
- Social-emotional skill-building
- Community and civic engagement

3. City/County – Trauma Recovery Center (TRC)

This three-year agreement funds trauma recovery services and wraparound support for both youth and adults. Central Health funding expands service reach beyond the contractual term, ensuring lasting impact.

AAYHF Conferences | Where it all began . . . Since 2006, AAYHF has served thousands of Central Texas youth in multiple school districts with special presentations and interactive workshops designed to build their academic, workforce, social-emotional, civic skills, and competencies. Through these conferences, our founder, Mr. Lofton, was able to identify specific needs within the community. The greatest need was having access to multiple resources, under one roof. Over the years, AAYHF has fostered relationships with a multitude of organizations and agencies to form a “one-stop-shop” in our building.

Strong and effective community partnerships are integral to AAYHF’s mission and service model. AAYHF connects community members to the in-house partners and a full array of external partners.

AAYHF DIRECT PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

The Harvest Trauma Recovery Center (HTRC) | We are the first Trauma Recovery Center, in the State of Texas. We provide comprehensive behavioral health services to survivors of recent violent crimes who are experiencing post-traumatic stress but are not receiving other mental health care. We provide a safe, yet brave space for survivors of traumatic experiences and violent crimes and their families, where they will receive essential assistance and needed services to thrive after experiencing traumatic events.

Family Wraparound Support | Connection to a broad array of services to address a spectrum of challenges, aimed at improving quality of life for families and stabilizing households so young people stay “on track”, developmentally and educationally. AAYHF has partnered with over 30 organizations, because we know we can’t meet every need for everyone who comes through our doors. Our direct access to our partners in the building eliminates the task of referring to outside agencies with long waiting periods to get an appointment and ensures our clients receive assistance expeditiously.

Employment/Employment Training | In collaboration with Travis County, Summer Youth Employment Training provides work-based experience to students as young as age 14.

KREW12 Media /Digital Media Program | The KREW12 program was designed as a multimedia development program initiated by the AAYHF to enhance the quality of life for AA youth and families in Central Texas. The goal is to groom the next generation of innovative youth leaders, thinkers, and doers through the innovative KREW12 program. KREW12 youth receive hands-on multi-media training and mentorship in digital and traditional media from industry students, experts, and practitioners.

Mentoring | Small group and one-to-one mentorship/Tutoring in a variety of settings, and connection to wraparound services, for youth identified as needing support. Mentoring is designed to connect the student and the mentor on a one-on-one basis, where the mentor can function as a friend, advocate, and life coach. The mentor also can connect the individual and family members to needbased Resources using case management. Group mentoring is structured so that the student connects on a deeper level with both parents, siblings, and mentor.



Families can come together and share their experiences, set goals, and plan for attainment. Goal setting is the focus of group mentoring, and we approach this task with persistence and passion.

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) | Everything Technology- Communications and Information Technology (IT) skill building programs with support from Dell. Courses include coding, 3D printing, robotics, and KREW 12 media production club. We offer Dell Certifications for High School students. AAYHF in partnership with Dell Technologies offers a Dell Tech Certification. Students will gain a skill set and trade by participating in this on-line self-service program by earning a Dell EMC products certification from TechDirect. The program consists of eight modules. Must have discipline to self-pace and attend bi-weekly sessions with instructor.

Esports | AAYHF Esports Learning Guide is designed to take students through rich immersive learning experiences to develop skills used in the esports industry and apply them for real world authentic purposes. Students will explore many aspects of esports as an industry, to help prepare them for the numerous opportunities available in college and career.

Training and Developmental Programs | Focus on Character and Behavioral Modification and Learning Programs utilizing the Research based program by John Maxwell. This training also includes Parenting and Family coaching program that was developed by Dr. Deborah Tillman (Lifetime Television America's Supernanny). We will equip, empower, and enlighten families to become the highest version of themselves so that the next generation has every opportunity to reach their divine destiny.

Training and Development programs focus on the following:

- **College & Career Readiness |** Focus on FAFSA, Dual Credit, Essay Writing, Scholarship Research, National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) and ACT testing. In addition, to college research and planning.

- **Mental, Physical and Social Well-Being Courses |** D'Affluenza, LLC | Processing and dealing with layers of individual trauma, on top of new mass traumas from COVID-19, adds compounding layers of complexity for individuals to responsibly manage their emotions and express their thoughts. Thus, the increased need for conflict, trauma and stress management training and education. This is a holistic approach in developing the individual by providing developmental accredited Continuing Professional Development (CDP) training that covers the categories of Mental, Physical and Social Well-Being. See courses categorized below under the headings: Mental, Physical and Social Well-Being.

This holistic approach embedded in our mission is to:

- Provide vernacular training as a resource to at-risk families with the goal of achieving self-sufficiency.
- Provide accredited professional development training to businesses with the goal of enhancing employee development.



The Youth and Family Mental Health and Wellness Center | Focuses on providing each child with the necessary skills to manage stress, promote academic engagement, and build positive relationships. Substance abuse education and planning for the future are also emphasized. We use a holistic approach to assist children and families in dealing with life challenges. Further, parents are shown positive and effective strategies for dealing with issues of parenting, as well as sharing their hard earned wisdom. Mentors give ongoing, individualized support and guidance. This approach to dealing with the whole child ensures positive outcomes for everyone involved. It follows the adage **“It takes a village to raise a child.”**

Urban University | A high impact summer program, to prevent summer learning loss and equip youth with the intellectual, social, and creative resources necessary for academic, career and life success.

Workforce Assistance & Readiness | Case management and skills training for older youth and adults to identify and successfully pursue career paths that will result in meaningful and family supporting employment.

DESCRIPCIONES DE PROGRAMAS DIRECTOS DE AAYHF

Centro de Recuperación de Trauma Harvest (HTRC) | Somos el primer Centro de Recuperación de Trauma en el estado de Texas. Proporcionamos servicios integrales de salud conductual a sobrevivientes

de crímenes violentos recientes que experimentan estrés postraumático pero no están recibiendo otra atención de salud mental. Proporcionamos un espacio seguro y valiente para los sobrevivientes de experiencias traumáticas y crímenes violentos y sus familias, donde recibirán asistencia esencial y servicios necesarios para prosperar después de experimentar eventos traumáticos.

Apoyo Familiar Integral | Conexión a una amplia gama de servicios para abordar un espectro de desafíos, con el objetivo de mejorar la calidad de vida de las familias y estabilizar los hogares para que los jóvenes se mantengan "en camino", tanto en desarrollo como en educación. AAYHF se ha asociado con más de 30 organizaciones, porque sabemos que no podemos satisfacer todas las necesidades de todos los que pasan por nuestras puertas. Nuestro acceso directo a nuestros socios en el edificio elimina la tarea de remitir a agencias externas con largos tiempos de espera para obtener una cita y asegura que nuestros clientes reciban asistencia de manera expedita.

Empleo/Capacitación Laboral | En colaboración con el Condado de Travis, la Capacitación de Empleo Juvenil de Verano proporciona experiencia laboral a estudiantes desde los 14 años.

KREW12 Media / Programa de Medios Digitales | El programa KREW12 fue diseñado como un programa de desarrollo multimedia iniciado por AAYHF para mejorar la calidad de vida de los jóvenes y familia afroamericanas en el Centro de Texas. El objetivo es formar a la próxima generación de líderes, pensadores y hacedores innovadores a través del innovador programa KREW12. Los jóvenes de KREW12 reciben capacitación práctica en multimedia y mentoría en medios digitales y tradicionales de estudiantes, expertos y profesionales de la industria.

Mentoría | Mentoría en grupos pequeños y uno a uno en una variedad de entornos, y conexión a servicios integrales para jóvenes identificados como necesitados de apoyo. La mentoría está diseñada para conectar al estudiante y al mentor de manera individual, donde el mentor puede funcionar como un amigo, defensor y coach de vida. El mentor también puede conectar al individuo y a los miembros de la familia con recursos basados en necesidades utilizando la gestión de casos. La mentoría grupal está estructurada de manera que el estudiante se conecte a un nivel más profundo tanto con los padres como con los hermanos y el mentor.



Las familias pueden reunirse y compartir sus experiencias, establecer metas y planificar su logro. El establecimiento de metas es el enfoque de la mentoría grupal, y abordamos esta tarea con persistencia y pasión.

STEM (Ciencia, Tecnología, Ingeniería, Matemáticas) | Todo sobre Tecnología: programas de desarrollo de habilidades en Comunicaciones y Tecnología de la Información (TI) con el apoyo de Dell. Los cursos incluyen codificación, impresión 3D, robótica y el club de producción de medios KREW 12. Ofrecemos certificaciones de Dell para estudiantes de secundaria. AAYHF, en asociación con Dell Technologies ofrece una certificación técnica de Dell. Los estudiantes adquirirán un conjunto de habilidades y un oficio participando en este programa en línea de autoservicio al obtener una certificación de productos Dell EMC de TechDirect. El programa consta de ocho módulos. Se requiere disciplina para auto-gestionar el tiempo y asistir a sesiones quincenales con el instructor.

Esports | La Guía de Aprendizaje de Esports de AAYHF está diseñada para llevar a los estudiantes a través de ricas experiencias de aprendizaje inmersivo para desarrollar habilidades utilizadas en la industria de los esports y aplicarlas a fines auténticos en el mundo real. Los estudiantes explorarán muchos aspectos de los esports como industria para ayudar a prepararlos para las numerosas oportunidades disponibles en la universidad y en su carrera.

Programas de Capacitación y Desarrollo | Enfocados en la modificación del carácter y el comportamiento, y programas de aprendizaje utilizando el programa basado en investigación de John Maxwell. Esta capacitación también incluye un programa de coaching para padres y familias desarrollado por la Dra. Deborah Tillman (Supernanny de Lifetime Television). Equiparemos, empoderaremos e iluminaremos a las familias para que se conviertan en la mejor versión de sí mismas de modo que la próxima generación tenga todas las oportunidades para alcanzar su destino divino.

Los programas de capacitación y desarrollo se centran en lo siguiente:

- **Preparación para la universidad y la carrera |** Enfocados en FAFSA, crédito dual, redacción de ensayos, investigación de becas, Asociación Nacional de Atletismo Colegiado (NCAA), Prueba de Evaluación Escolar (SAT) y pruebas ACT. Además, investigación y planificación universitaria.
- **Cursos de Bienestar Mental, Físico y Social | D’Affluenza, LLC |** Procesar y lidiar con capas de trauma individual, además de nuevos traumas masivos debido al COVID-19, añade capas de complejidad que las personas deben gestionar responsablemente para manejar sus emociones y expresar sus pensamientos. Por lo tanto, hay una creciente necesidad de capacitación y educación en gestión de conflictos, trauma y estrés. Este es un enfoque holístico para desarrollar al individuo proporcionando capacitación de Desarrollo Profesional Continuo (CPD) acreditada que cubre las categorías de Bienestar Mental, Físico y Social. Vea los cursos categorizados a continuación bajo los encabezados: Bienestar Mental, Físico y Social.
